### What if I don't know much about CCAHEC?

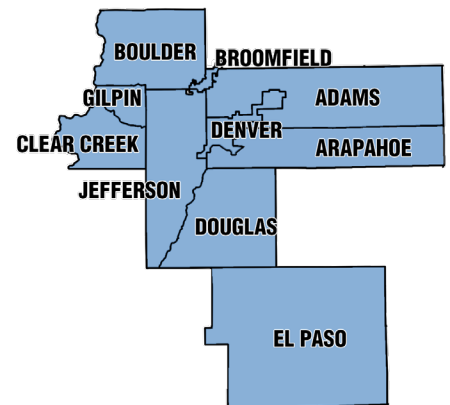

### How much time does this require?

Thanks to the University of Colorado Denver, we use ZOOM video conferencing for our Executive Committee Meetings (6/year) and for half of our Full Board Meetings (6/year). Meetings are typically less than 1.5 hours. Full board physical meetings will only take place 3 times per year, plus a full-day strategic planning session. Committee participation is encouraged. Our committees include: Executive, Programs, Finance, Board Membership, and ad-hoc sub committees.

On average, you should expect a time commitment of no more than 6 hours max per month.

### Be honest, do you just want my money?

Nope. We want directors with knowledge, skill, ideas, and passion for improving the future of healthcare. Yes, we ask for a personally significant financial contribution, but there is no fixed amount. We ARE a non-profit, but we'd rather have active board members who can help us identify new funding sources than nickle and dime our directors.

### I don't have much board experience. Is that ok?

It is definitely ok. We are committed to board development and education to ensure everyone has the needed foundation to be successful.
